7. Construction Updates

NORTH CAMPUS

- A. Neighboring construction on hold for now; Miami-Dade County inspectors visited the site, there's nothing they can do; **update: EFAM put up green privacy screen around construction site; city filled the trenches with asphalt.**
- B. EFAM construction estimated at around \$ 250 000
 - Fence to replace the 650 wall; **updates: survey obtained, we are waiting for permits**
 - Playground extension
 - Renovation of Biscayne offices = multipurpose room for students, library, storage, office space, food storage area
 - Next steps: survey to be conducted on February 9 and February 12 plans by architect permits

9. Q & A

Parent - Are the Parents' Club fundraisers linked to the school's fundraisers? **EFAM** - They are not. **CDP** The Club raises money to fund their various community events (kermesse, movie night) and to provide the little extras that enhance the children's school experience (*galette des rois, Santa's visit*). They also allocate part of their funds to meet specific needs of the school (ex- new playground equipment, parent workshop by PPA). We are in constant communication with the school. **EFAM** - The Club is a fundamental part in creating the sense of community at EFAM.

Parent - Some parents, especially French parents, don't understand this culture of fundraising. I suggest you communicate more. **EFAM** - This is now mentioned in all the interviews with prospective families.

Parent- So if you do not meet the annual fund goal, the school won't provide the professional development (and other things mentioned in the list)? I believe that this should be covered by the tuition as they are necessary. **EFAM** - The annual fund's priority is construction. Other items, like professional development are provided no matter the funds raised. The goal is modest and does not aim to cover the entirety of these expenses, the goal is to have sufficient funds to be able to provide for the school's needs as they arise, without having to forego certain expenses that exceed our budget. The cost of construction far outweighs the cost of author visits and professional development.

Parent - When will the 650 North campus playground wall be fixed? **EFAM** - We are working on it. Replacing the wall will be included in the 650 playground and building on Biscayne restoration. It will be included in the survey and architectural plans. Survey is scheduled this week. **Update - survey was done end of February**

Parent - How much does the school raise on No Uniform Days? Is it not best to just increase the tuition? **EFAM** - Between \$1000 to \$3000 per event. **Parent** - Some parents think that the communication regarding the No Uniform Days connecting a donation in order to not wear the uniform is not adequate and should be worded differently. **EFAM** - No Uniform Day is a fundraiser and the objective is to get as many donations as possible. It is also a fun day for the children that has existed since the creation of EFAM. EFAM accepts all children at school without a uniform even if the parents have not made a donation. We will review the email.

Parent- Is the 651 playground fence permanent? **EFAM** - No, it is temporary during the neighboring construction. The fence will remain there to protect the playground until the construction is completed. **Parent** - Will the permanent fence be at the same location? **EFAM** - The permanent fence will be closer to the wall separating the neighboring construction.

Parent - Does EFAM plan to accept the Florida vouchers for the coming school year? **EFAM** - No, as of now EFAM does not plan to accept the vouchers in the future.

Parent - When is the deadline for donations for the gala? EFAM - Update - donations accepted until mid-April Parent - Is the wine & liquor for the prizes for the gala? EFAM - It will mainly be to serve at the gala. We will also need some as prizes. Parent - Is the gala organized by the Parents' Club? EFAM - No, it is a school initiative: the Wine & Cheese is hosted by the Club, the Gala is hosted by the school.

Parent - How many volunteers do you need for the Gala committee? **EFAM** - There is no maximum number, we really need help.
